Prayer focus for April 2025

Waiting, watching, walking.

I say to myself, "The Lord is my portion; therefore, I will wait for him."

The Lord is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him; it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord.

Lamentation 3:24-26

As we journey through Lent we are encouraged to slow down, to take time to wait on God. This is a wilderness time, a time of preparation.

As we approach Easter we see Jesus take time to wait on God in prayer. He asks the Disciples to wait in prayer with him. He knows what lies ahead. Waiting on God is not easy. We see the disciples struggle to wait with him. We watch our Lords anguish in the Garden of Gethsemane, yet see his complete obedience to God in going to the cross. Let us stand firm in Christ and wait on God who is faithful. He alone knows what and whom he has planned for us. Let us watch and pray to see what God will do and walk on in faith, hope and trust.

Fill the valleys; level the hills; straighten out the crooked paths, and smooth off the rough spots in the road. The glory of the Lord will be seen by all mankind together." The Lord has spoken—it shall be.
